



## **Directions to Fraport's General Aviation Terminal**

The General Aviation Terminal (GAT), is in Building 514 and is south of Runway 25L/07R of Frankfurt Airport. The terminal is in "Cargo City Süd" of the airport and is thus close to the city center of Frankfurt, and within reasonable distance to other German cities.

The GAT, combined with the motivation of the FRAPORT Executive Aviation team, offers excellent service and short distances, without delay.

Travel to the GAT can be done with your private vehicle as well as a taxi or limousine.

When you approach the airport with the A5 from the north, you drive through the "Frankfurter Kreuz". Please follow the directions for "Frankfurter Flughafen" (English: Frankfurt Airport) but continue further to the exit, "Cargo City Süd" (English: Cargo City South). When one approaches the airport, on the A5, from the south, you will, of course, see the exit shortly before the Frankfurter Kreuz. Follow the signs to "Tor 32" (English: Gate 32). When you reach Tor 32, you must register with the gate guards, showing ID and giving your license number.

After this, you must drive through Cargo City Süd, following the signposts to GAT/Geb. 514. You pass Tor 112, which will be on your right and must turn right immediately afterwards. Then you take the second left turn. Immediately after the DB Schenker building you take the right turn and you will be driving between the DB Schenker building and the Lufthansa Technik building, directly to the GAT.

When coming from the A3 autobahn, please drive direction Frankfurter Kreuz/Basel/Stuttgart and follow the signs for Flughafen Frankfurt. At the Autobahnkreuz (English: freeway intersection) 48 – Mönchhof-Dreieck, please use the left lane, direction München/Würzburg. Change lanes then to the right and take the exit Flughafen Frankfurt. Keep to the right and take the turn, direction Cargo City Süd. At the traffic lights, turn right again and follow the Airport Ring looking for the signposts to Tor 31 (English: Gate 31).

At Tor 31 you must register with the gate guards and then the signs to the GAT, once again, driving between the DB Schenker building and the Lufthansa Technik building.
